AN ORDINANCE OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, CHANGING THE ZONING DISTRICT BOUNDARIES BY REZONING A PORTION OF SECTION 5, TOWNSHIP 48 SOUTH, RANGE 41 EAST; FROM UNZONED TO RS-3, RESIDENTIAL SINGLE-FAMILY DETACHED DWELLING DISTRICT; PROVIDING FOR AMENDMENT OF THE ZONING DISTRICT MAPS; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF ALL REZONING ORDINANCES AND ZONING RESOLUTIONS IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; PROVIDING THAT THIS REZONING SHALL NOT BE CONSTRUED TO CREATE A RIGHT TO DEVELOPMENT THAT FAILS TO MEET THE REQUIREMENTS OF OTHER LAND DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

AN ORDINANCE OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, CHANGING THE ZONING DISTRICT BOUNDARIES BY REZONING A PORTION OF A PORTION OF SECTION 15, TOWNSHIP 49 SOUTH, RANGE 42 EAST; FROM R-1C, ONE-FAMILY DWELLING DISTRICT TO RSO, RESIDENTIAL SINGLE-FAMILY DETACHED AND OFFICE DISTRICT UTILIZING THE 5% FLEXIBILITY RULE; PROVIDING FOR AMENDMENT OF THE ZONING DISTRICT MAPS; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF ALL REZONING ORDINANCES AND ZONING RESOLUTIONS IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; PROVIDING THAT THIS REZONING SHALL NOT BE CONSTRUED TO CREATE A RIGHT TO DEVELOPMENT THAT FAILS TO MEET THE REQUIREMENTS OF OTHER LAND DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
